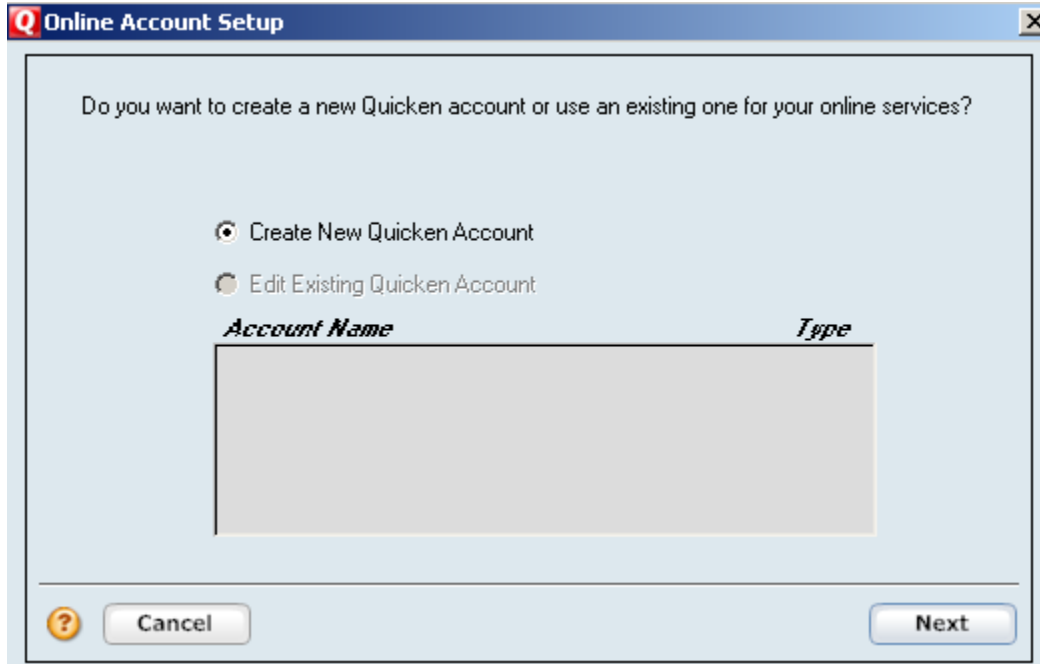
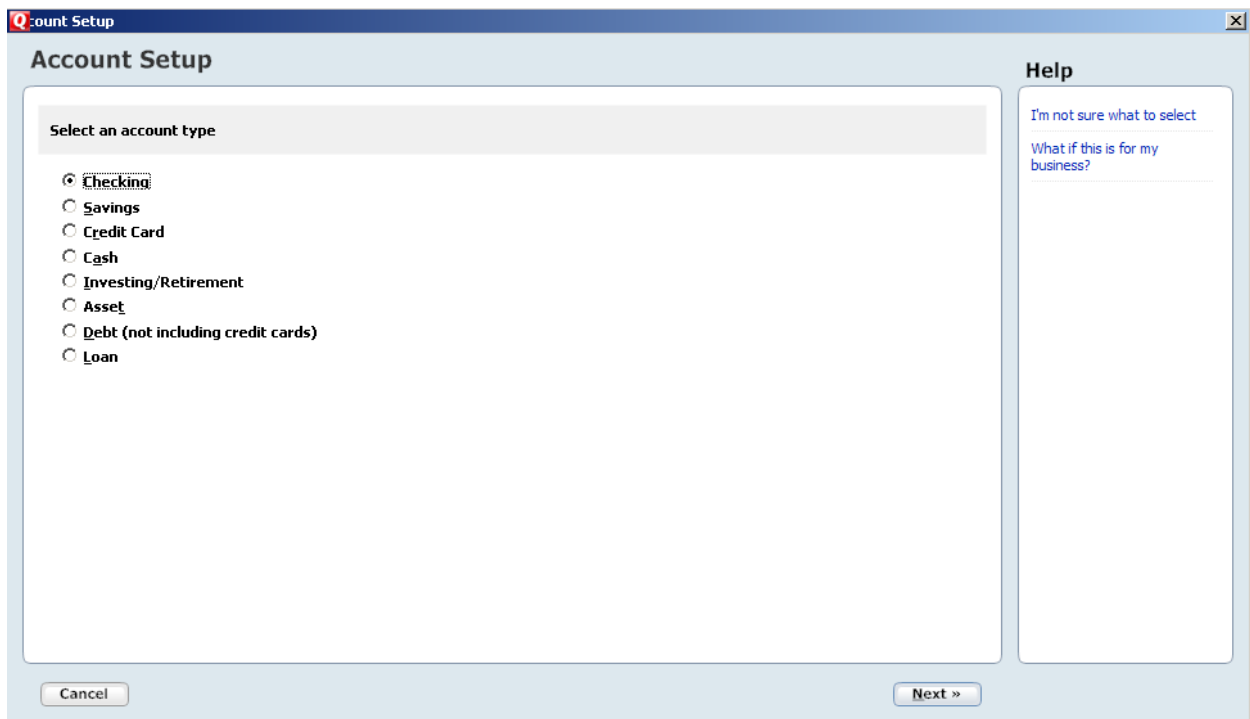


2. Select Create New Quicken Account.

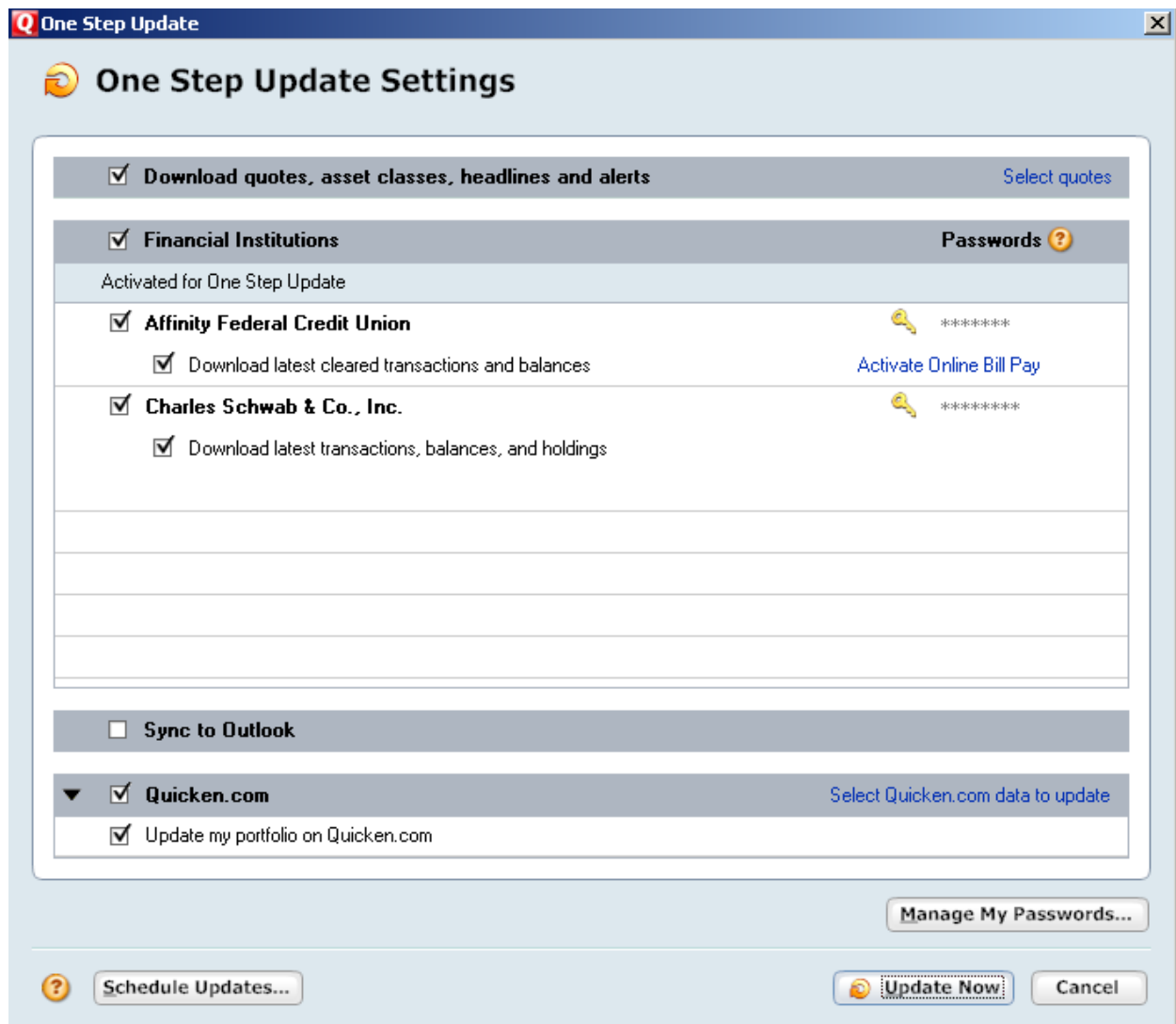
